



BISA BEHAVIOUR POLICY

What we believe in:

A safe and supportive learning environment: All students deserve to feel safe and respected at school. We have clear rules and expectations to help everyone learn and grow.

Positive behaviour: We encourage kindness, respect, responsibility, and hard work. We celebrate good choices and help students learn from mistakes.

Restorative practices: When problems arise, we focus on understanding and repairing harm. We work together to find solutions that make things right.

What we expect from students:

Be safe and sensible: Follow rules, wear the correct uniform, and take care of yourself and others.

Be respectful: Treat everyone with kindness and fairness, even when you disagree.

Be responsible: Follow instructions, do your best work, and take ownership of your actions.

Learn and grow: Be curious, ask questions, and try your best.

What we expect from parents:

Work with us: We are a team! Please talk to your child about the school rules and expectations.

Communicate with us: Let us know if you have any concerns about your child's behaviour.

Support us: We all have a role to play in creating a positive school environment.

What happens when students make mistakes:

Minor misbehaviour: We use verbal warnings, written warnings, and meetings with form tutors to address minor issues.

More serious problems: For things like repeated disobedience, bullying, or damaging property, we may involve parents, the child may be involved in community service relating to their mistake, or, in some cases, suspend students.

Extreme behaviour: In very serious cases, such as drug use or violence, we may involve the police or expel students.

How we reward good behaviour:

We praise and encourage positive choices and attitudes.

We celebrate achievements and success.

We offer rewards and incentives, such as merits and special privileges.

Working together for a positive school community:

We believe that all students can succeed in a safe and supportive environment. By working together, we can create a school where everyone feels respected, valued, and ready to learn.
