PREVENTION IS BETTER THAN CURE

We are looking forward to reopening the school at the end of August. We have spent a lot of time consulting with a lot of people and organisations to work out how we can reduce risk whilst minimizing disruption and protecting students and staff from discrimination. We are constantly learning and we need to continue to work together in partnership: being flexible about how we navigate the re-opening together. We would like to reassure you that although we are suggesting some short-term changes to the way that we operate, we 'æ' would like our school to continue to be welcoming, respectful, inclusive, and supportive for all. Following the guidelines from WHO we feel that prevention is better than cure and so have planned for the following:

IF YOUR CHILD FEELS SICK

- Please do not send your child to school if they are suffering from:
 - A persistent dry cough
 - A fever
 - Shortness of breath
 - Loss of smell/taste
- Please keep your child at home for 7 days after the symptoms have gone.
- We will send a work pack home and the class teacher will be in touch by e-mail or Zoom so your child does not miss out on their learning.
- We will no longer offer awards based on attendance.



TEMPERATURE CHECK

- All visitors to the school site will have their temperature checked before entering the school premises.
- If a high temperature is detected, parents will be contacted.

HAND WASHING

- Everyone will wash their hands on arrival to and departure from school.
- Everyone will use hand sanitizer before entering a classroom and before they leave.
- Everyone will wash their hands after going to the toilet.
- Everyone will wash their hands before and after eating.





SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Tables and chairs in our classrooms and outside will be at least 1.5m apart.
- Windows and doors will be kept open.
- The planning and delivery of practical subjects will incorporate social distancing.

LIMIT PEOPLE ON SITE

- Please do not accompany your child onto the school site.
- If you need to speak to us please call or email and we will arrange to see you after school in a designated outdoor meeting space.

LIMIT THE SIZE OF GROUPS

- In classrooms, play areas and in the dining area.
- Postpone events that would attract a crowd.
