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IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SCHOOL FEES – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. Tuition Fees indicate costs for tuition, exercise books, loan of textbooks and participation in clubs (other than those provided by outside experts). Fees for additional services are indicated and are charged separately.
2. There are two transport options available to parents whose children are in Primary or Secondary; either for their children to be collected and dropped off at a central point or a door-to-door service within any of the zoned A-D areas shown below. For parents with children in the Early Years Centre only a door-to-door service is available.
3. The boarding fees include accommodation, home study support from teachers, transport when required, meals, bedding/mosquito net, Internet access, email and DSTV. Medical cover is explained in the application form.

The boarding activity fee, which is billed separately, is used for trips and excursions organized by boarding and teaching staff. Students are expected to participate in a range of these events. Any fee remaining at the end of a term will be carried over to the following term and will be reflected in the term's/year's 'top-up' fee.

4. Applications for placement at the school are only processed on the return of a **duly completed APPLICATION FORM** and on the payment of a **non-refundable ENROLMENT FEE**

5. ADDITIONAL COSTS

- i. **Day, Residential and Sports Excursions:** Day, residential and sporting trips form important elements of our curricular and extra-curricular activities. These are charged for separately.
 - ii. **Examination fees:** Students sitting IGCSE, AS and A level examinations and BTEC assessments will be invoiced separately for these during term one. Fees for examinations are approximately USD 70 per subject for IGCSE, AS and A levels. This cost includes registration, entry and postage and packing. Other examinations with entry fees will be invoiced throughout the year e.g, NEA or ABRSM.
6. Fees are billed in **AUGUST, DECEMBER** and **APRIL**. **Payment should be made at the school's bank, not at the school. Please consult the fees office for bank details. The school relies on the timely payment of fees in order to provide a quality education for all of its students**
 7. **EARLY PAYMENT DISCOUNT:** Fees are payable on or before the first day of each term. A **discount of 3% on TUITION fees for the next term**, is given when **FULL** payment is made **within 6 days of the due date**. A **discount of 5% is given if the full annual fees are paid prior to the start of the first term**.
 8. **FAMILY DISCOUNTS, on TUITION FEES only** are given as follows:
2nd Child: 10%, 3rd Child: 15%, 4th & subsequent Child: 17.5%
 9. If fees remain unpaid at the end of the second week of term, parents will receive a reminder note and students may be excluded from school unless arrangements have been made with the Head Teacher. A **SURCHARGE of 1.25% is levied PER MONTH** on all outstanding fees.
 10. **A FULL TERM'S NOTICE in writing** and the **HEADTEACHER'S acknowledgement in writing of the same** is required for withdrawals else, a **FULL TERM'S FEES IS PAYABLE** in lieu of such notice.
 11. **NECTA students: Sixth Form foundation course**
Running from January to July of the year following the NECTA examinations, this course prepares NECTA students to succeed in the CIE or Pearson A levels so they can progress to an international university of their choice. Tuition fees: TZS 13,600,000 or USD 5,110 from January to July. In August, students join year 12 at the start of the 2-year A level course. Normal fees, detailed above are then applicable.
